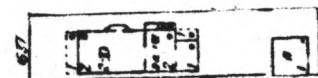

STATEMENT

This example of an important local house type displays an unusual facade treatment in which windows and entrance are set within a slightly recessed plane. Simple molded iron hoods provide the only other decorative touch.

DESCRIPTION

This house was built prior to 1882. Its occupant beginning in 1884 was F. J. Raible, an emplcer of Oho Albrecht and Company, a cigar and tobacco manufacturing firm.
