SIGNIFICANCE

This building was the headquarters of the German Knights of Labor, an important union to form out of the labor agitation of the 1880's. Its location in the German west end south of the Rock Island Railroad enhances its significance.

DESCRIPTION

The German Knights of Labor, Chapter #2144, organized in c. 1886 amidst a flurry of union activities. The German Chapter was begun as a result of dissention in the local labor movement. Germans advocated a class, political view of union activity while non-German workers charged these ideas were alien.
