INDIAN MOUND

In 1884, an archaeological investigation uncovered the remains of a fortification on a hill near the site of the mound. The fortification was discovered, and it is a large log stockade built on top of the mound, along with a large square of stone. The mound was built in the Adams Culture, about 1,200 B.C. as the ancestral language of the State of West Virginia and the site of many mounds and earthworks that once were found in the Charleston area.
