Located one mile north of the Village of Montrose, Bridge No. 44-212-090 carries an unpaved road over the East Fork of the Vermillion River. Resting on steel pile abutments with plank wing walls and back wall, this 37-foot bridge consists of three rolled steel girders carrying I-beam floor beams and I-beam stringers. The connections are bolted and the decking is timber. The bridge's railing is constructed of angle-section posts and rails with lattice-work bars. State highway department records indicate reconstruction work in 1960, which probably refers to rebuilding of the abutments. The bridge retains very good integrity. NPS Form 10-900-a (8-86)

Bridge no. 44-212-090 is being nominated to the National Register of Historic Places as part of the "Historic Bridges in South Dakota" Multiple Property Nomination. It is related to the historic context of "Historic Bridges in South Dakota, 1893-1943" and is classified with the associated property type for steel stringer and steel girder bridges. This bridge is individually eligible for the National Register under Criterion C as an early example of a steel deck girder, and for its association with the Standard Bridge Company. The bridge retains very good integrity.

The Standard Bridge Company was organized in Omaha in 1900 by Robert Z. Drake. Drake was born and educated in Kansas and began building bridges in the early 1890s when he was in his early twenties. Besides working as a contractor, he was an innovator developing a configuration of steel pilings for bridge substructures and the transverse joist bridge. He also developed standardized plans for truss bridges that were widely used in Nebraska and elsewhere. Bridge No. 44-212-090, a transverse joist structure, represents the Standard Bridge Company's development of various steel girder structures, of which the transverse joist bridge was one type.

Bridge No. 44-212-090 was authorized in January 1914, when the McCook County Commissioners approved a petition that a "thirty-six foot steel bridge be put in between Sections 15 & 22 in Montrose Township." Although county records do not provide a completion date, the structure was presumably built that same year by Standard Bridge Company of Omaha, which had been the successful bidder on the county's annual bridge building contract since 1903. This bridge represents a very early example of a steel girder bridge, as it was not until after the turn of the century that I-beams gained acceptance in bridge construction for use in short span applications, supplanting timber stringers.
