LOS BURROS RANGER STATION

THIS CABIN AND THE BARN NEARBY ARE ALL THAT REMAINS OF THE RANGER STATION CONSTRUCTED IN 1891-1892. ABOUT 240 ACRES WERE SET ASIDE FOR ADMINISTRATIVE USE. THIS USE CONSISTED MAINLY OF A FIRE GUARD WHO RODE HIS HORSE EACH DAY TO LAKE MOUNTAIN LOOKOUT OR TO FIGHT FIRES OCCURRING IN THE AREA.

LOS BURROS SPRING LOCATED JUST EAST OF THE CABIN PROVIDED WATER FOR THE RANGER STATION AND STOCK ANIMALS.

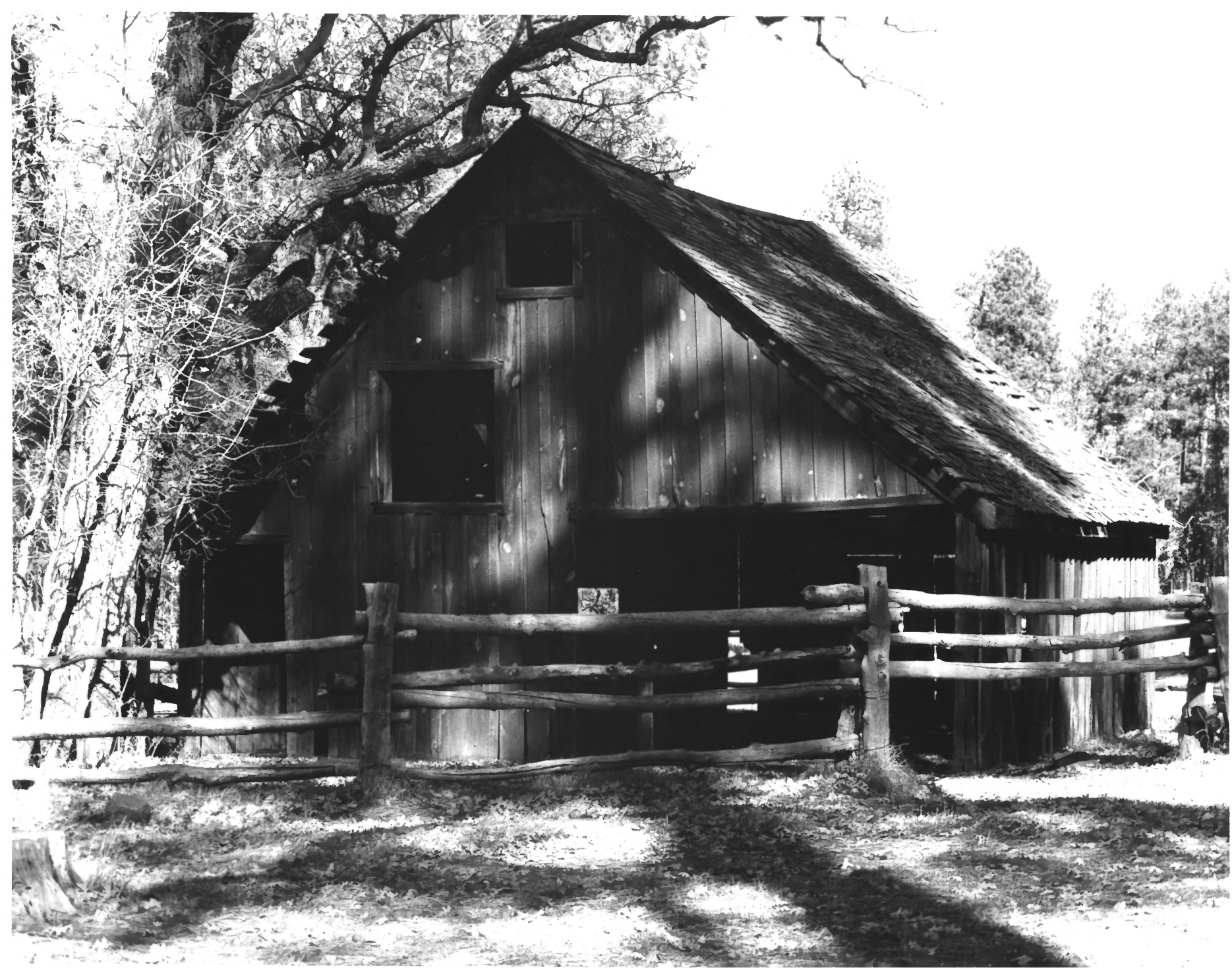
