DISCUSSION AS REQUIRED: The rear addition does not detract from the significance of this early adobe Queen Anne style residence. It is the only adobe Queen Anne remaining intact in Safford. It is significant for its architecture and detailing apparent in the facade pediment in addition to the structural material which is not found in the early developed neighborhoods of Safford. No one of historical significance is known to have lived in this home, except an early mid-wife, whose name and dates of occupancy are unknown.
