

Description

Located on State Highway 327 at its crossing of the Little Buffalo River (approximately 1.5 miles northwest of Parthenon and 1/2 mile south of Union Hill Cemetery), the Little Buffalo River Bridge is of the open masonry substructure (concrete tee beam) type. It consists of a total of seven spans with a maximum span length of 30 feet. The total bridge length is 212 feet, the width is 19.1 feet curb to curb, and the overall width is 22.3 feet. The two abutments and six piers are constructed of stone and concrete, and the deck material is reinforced concrete with asphalt overlay. A reinforced concrete balustrade runs down each side of the deck.

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Significance

Constructed in 1939, the Little Buffalo River Bridge is associated with the *Arkansas Highway* and *Transportation Era* historic context and is of the open masonry substructure type. Though the identity of its original designer does not survive, it was constructed in conjunction with the Arkansas State Highway Commission and thus may well have been designed by one of that state agency's engineers, if not by one of the public works engineers. Given its relatively intact condition it retains sufficient integrity to remain associated with both the WPA and its historic period; it is thus locally eligible under Criteria A and C.

Beginning at a point formed by the intersection of the northwestern edge of State Highway 327 with a perpendicular line running parallel with the northeastern end of the bridge and located approximately 25 feet to the northeast thereof, proceed northwesterly for a distance of approximately 25 feet to its intersection with a perpendicular line running parallel with the bridge's northwestern side; thence proceed southwesterly along said line for a distance of approximately 262 feet to its intersection with a perpendicular line; thence proceed southeasterly along said line for a distance of approximately 72.3 feet to its intersection with a perpendicular line; thence proceed northeasterly along said line for a distance of approximately 262 feet to its intersection with a perpendicular line; thence proceed northwesterly to the point of beginning.
