ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

One-story gable-roof frame residence with pedimented tetrastyle portico. Entrance frontispiece with pilasters, side lights and transom framed by shouldered architrave trim with slight pediment. Paired vertical panels on each side of frontispiece. Wide entablature and boxed cornice with returns on gabled side (north and south) facades; pilasters at all corners. Center-hall plan; two interior chimneys.

The Bradshaw-Booth house is architecturally significant as a well-proportioned moderately sized Greek Revival country residence. Its entrance frontispiece is one of the county's outstanding examples because of its design and workmanship.

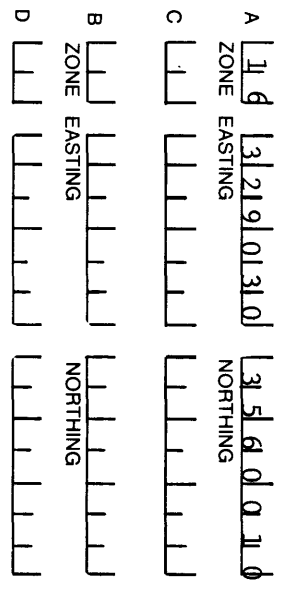
