This is among the most significant of lowa's county courthouses, and is notable as one of the few remaining in the Greek Revival style. The recessed portico, with curved staircases hidden behind the front corners of the building, is perhaps unique in the state. Note the emphasis on the main facade, in terms of detail and masonry treatment: side and rear walls are simply quarry faced stone.

This courthouse was a victim of county seat rivalry, serving its original function only from 1861 to 1867.

The county courthouse is locally significant as the historical focus of county seat government, and of the political power and prestige derived from the community's status as the county seat. As center of county government, an lowa town was reasonably assured of economic and population growth, and a prominent role in local social and political life. The county courthouse represents a significant public investment in a structure built not simply for utilitarian purposes, but also as a monument associated with the historical importance of county organization and development.
