

Physical Description

This exceptionally long, rectangular structure exhibits a strong Art Deco influence. The two-story school, faced with red brick, has a flat roof and is set on a low cast stone foundation. The massing is composed of three blocks: a projecting central block, and two flanking ones. The entire facade is organized into bays with single windows articulated by long, slender brick piers terminating in simple stone blocks. These stone blocks and the stone sills beneath each window create strong and colorful horizontal rhythms which counteract the verticality of the brick piers. The blocks are differentiated through the use of smaller, narrow windows on the central block. The entrance is marked by a projecting cast stone segmental arch opening framed by slender vertical panels with pointed corners in stylized geometric motifs. Marking the entrance at parapet level are a series of rectangular stone panels carved with stylized geometric motifs.

Statement of Significance

In 1930 the firm of Thompson, Sanders, and Ginocchio designed the Newport Junior and Senior High School Building. Constructed that same year, the building is one of the few Art Deco-influenced designs in the nomination based on the firm's drawing collection. The Newport School displays the "streamlined modern" concept in architecture at the time. This school is unique to the nominated structures in its variation from the historical details which characterized many of the firm's large buildings. The Newport School is a two-story red brick building which features the traits of Art Deco design in its straight geometric lines. The long rectangular building is marked by a projecting entrance of cast stone. This arched entrance features slender vertical panels with geometric motifs. Located in a complex of Newport public school buildings in a park setting, the Newport Junior and Senior High School is an important historic structure to the northeastern Arkansas city.
