45. Description and House Plan:

Late dry-stone building, size ca. 30 x 75 feet, with shallow gable roof. Masonry in regular courses of nearly equal height; stones spall-faced, tooled square edges; solid stone lintels and sills; some lintels and sills are bush-hammered with chiseled edges; masonry also has chiseled edges at openings; lintels topped by three stones having splayed keystone in center; watertable; narrow frames with mitered corners; roof rafters rest on ridge beam.

Interior is two spaces. The south space, about one-third of the building, is near ground level, and houses the office of the station master and freight agent; was heated by a wood stove with interior chimney. The large space is raised three feet above ground to allow for loading and unloading. Original scales and "truck" are still there.

Passenger station on south end of building now used as office. Two doorway thresholds have been heightened.

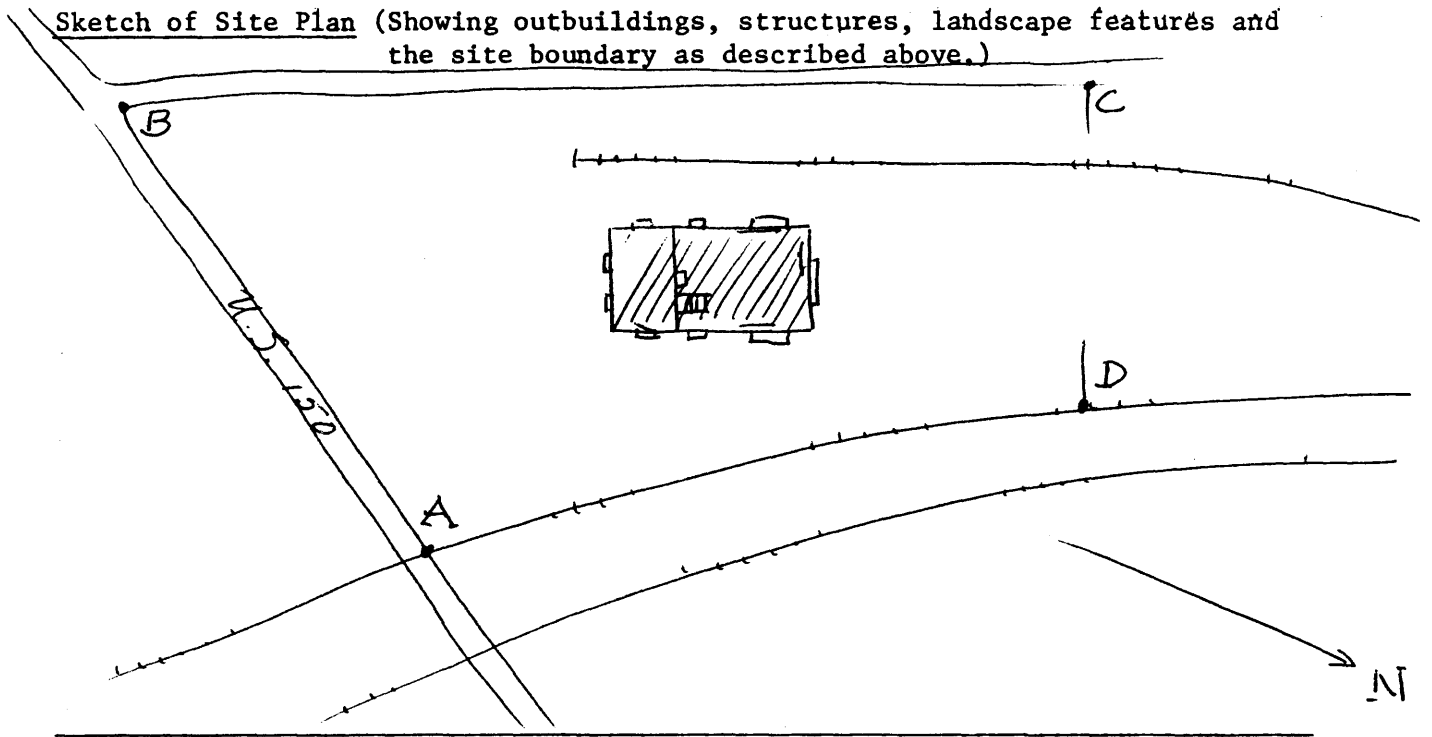
