#### DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Pomham Rocks Light Station consists of approximately ½ of an acre situated atop of promontory approximately 200 yards off the mainland of East Providence at the upper reaches of Narragansett Bay in what is called the Providence River.

Electricity and telephone services to the Island are provided by underwater cables running from the mainland. Sewage disposal is by septic tank.

The main dwelling is wood frame on a granite base 28 ft X 28 ft with a wooden light tower attached 34 ft high. Dwelling and tower were constructed in 1871.

Adjacent to the main dwelling and light tower is a wood/brick frame storage built in 1871 which was internally converted to a generator building in 1957.

On the opposite side of the main dwelling from the generator building is an active modular galvanized light tower which was erected in 1974.

At the lower end of the island is a 12 ft X 130 ft concrete seawall built in 1939 annexed by a timber on pile L shaped wharf.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Pomham Rocks was acquired by the US Government in 1871 and the dwelling, storage buildings, light towers and fog signal were installed shortly after. The Light Station was then established by the Treasury Department's Lighthouse Board in the same year. The Light Station is situated on ½ of an acre, approximately 200 yards off the mainland of East Providence, at the upper reaches of Narragansett Bay, in the Providence River.

The light and keepers quarters are combined in a single masonry structure of handsome proportions and High Victorian design.

The Light Station is among one of the oldest stations situated on Narragansett Bay and has long served as both a functional and picturesque landmark for the East Providence community. For the past 107 years the station has guided ships in the main channel leading into Providence Harbor.


Electricity was first brought to the island 15 years ago. Until the spring of 1974, it served as a manned Light Station. In May, 1974 the Coast Guard constructed a new modular galvanized light tower adjacent to the original light station. With this new construction the original station was decommissioned and vacated by the Coast Guard.

DESCRIPTION:

Pomham Rocks Light Station occupies a small island in the Providence River about 1000 feet off the East Providence coast. The main building, erected in 1871, is a one-and-one-half-story, mansard-roofed, 28-by-28-foot, wood-frame keeper's house on a granite foundation. A wooden light tower rises two more stories at the center of the west side of the house. To the east of the house is a small, gable-roofed, brick and wood-frame storage building, also erected in 1871 and converted in 1957 into a generator building. West of the hosue is a modular, galvanized-metal light tower constructed in 1974. Near the eastern end of the island, a timber-on-pile, L-shaped wharf is connected to a 12-foot-by-130-foot concrete sea wall built in 1939.

The light tower west of the hosue has been oeprating since its construction in 1974. At that time the original beacon was deactivated and the dwelling was vacated by the Coast Guard. The property is now maintained by the Rhode Island Historical Society.

DATES: 1871

SIGNIFICANCE:

Pomham Rocks Light Station is one of the oldest stations on Narragansett Bay and has served as a functional and picturesque landmark for over one hundred years. Pomham Rock was acquired by the U.S. Government in 1871 and the station was established and built the same year by the Lighthouse Board of the U.S. Treasury Department. It was one of a series constructed to guide marine traffic in and out of Providence Harbor. It conformed to a standard design widely used by the Treasury Department at the time and is today a well preserved example of its type: the combined keeper's dwelling with light tower.

ACREAGE: less than one acre

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION: The northwesterly island in a group of two islands known as Pomham Rocks, situated in the Providence River approximately 1000 feet from the East Providence shore.
