1790 - CHARLES W. CHRISTMAS - 1904  
THE FIRST COUNTY SURVEYOR,  
HENNEPIN COUNTY, MINNESOTA

IN MAY 1851, CHAS. W. CHRISTMAS  
MADE THE FIRST SURVEY ON THE WEST  
SIDE OF THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER,  
UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE  
SECRETARY OF THE OLD SETTLERS'  
ASSOCIATION. HE EXTENDED THE  
GOVERNMENT LINES ACROSS THE RIVER  
FROM THE 4<sup>TH</sup> PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN AS  
FAR AS LAKE CALHOUN, THIS ENABLING  
THE EARLY SETTLERS TO ESTABLISH  
CLAIM LINES IN WHAT IS NOW  
MINNEAPOLIS. LATER THESE LINES  
WERE FOUND TO BE CORRECT BY THE  
UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT AND  
WERE ADOPTED TO  
THEIR PLAN.

BUILT BY THE CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS ON ORIGINAL PLACE  
WHICH WAS LOST BY SANDALS DURING 1870'S
