The Warshauer Mansion in Antonito, Colorado, designed by George F. Harvey of Denver for Fred Benjamen Warshauer in 1912, stands as a fine example of scale, simplicity, and grace. Constructed of pressed brick laid in stretcher bond, it is trimmed throughout with wood milled in Iowa and shipped to Antonito for installation. The second floor is accented with stucco within the exposed within the pediment formed by the gable and simply decorated frieze. While attention to detail is paid throughout, nonetheless, the front of the house received the greatest of the economically employed motif.

The structure is built on a balanced, slightly modified "H" plan with no one facade particularly dominant. It is a two story building with full basement. The bellcast roof gables are overlaid with red tile and are set off with simply decorated bargeboards and returns. Chimneys are symmetrically placed, toward the inside in the front and the outside in the back; a fifth chimney is placed in the center rear of the house.

Window and door lintels are flat throughout, the front, first floor only boasting stone and brick labels. First floor windows are double hung and have six light transoms while the second floor main windows are set off with wooden bal ustrades. Other decorative motif s include brackets at the gable ends, dentils along the friezes that are carried over very simply to brickwork supporting window sills, and a stringcourse subtly separating the basement from the first floor.

On the inside, exposed frame ceilings and extensive paneling, again decorated in a very appealing economy, lend an instant compatibility with the outside. A local Denver artist, Jens Eriksen who attended art school for six years in his native Copenhagen, was commissioned to decorate the interior with the many murals found throughout the residence. Unusual for the period were such built in facilities as a central vacuum cleaning system and fire control system. The house also boasts of steam heat and an intercom system.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Fred B. Warshauer, who was born in Posen, Germany in 1859, emigrated to America and reached Antonito, Colorado at the age of twenty. Speaking little English, he was first employed in a local mercantile store where he not only learned the merchandising business but English and Spanish as well. In 1889, he went into business for himself as a real estate and loan agent, having by then risen in prominance socially, politically, and economically in the region.

Mr. Warshauer established himself in banking and lumbering in addition to raising hogs, but it was principally sheep raising that brought him to his greatest prominence. His sheep interests eventually monopolized Conejos and other surrounding county markets. Long susceptible to fits of depression and ill health, however, he had reached the zeniath of his economic and social rise when he killed himself, leaving to his survivers several companies and a sizable fortune.

Self-educated and self-made, his home, which included a large library, remained a show case in the San Luis Valley of southern Colorado.
