As center of county government, an Iowa town was reasonably assured of economic and population growth, and a prominent role in local social and political life. The county courthouse represents a significant public investment in a structure built not simply for utilitarian purposes, but also as a monument associated with the historical importance of county organization and development. The first courthouse in Washington County built by public funds was an 18 by 28 foot two-story structure made of oak and walnut lumber. It was used not only as office space and for court sessions, but also for school and religious services. The total cost of construction was \$759.

In February of 1845, the county board of commissioners negotiated a contract for the building of a second courthouse. In July of 1847 the contractor presented the new building to the board which was dissatisfied with the work performed. Fifty dollars was deducted for the carpentry work on the cupola and another \$110 was deducted on the balance of the building. The architect who designed the second courthouse was offered as his commission the choice of any unsold lots in Washington, Iowa, at \$5.00 each. The property values must have been inflated because it does not appear that the architect took

The third courthouse in Washington is the present courthouse built for \$75,000 and completed in 1887. The brick in this building was manufactured locally at the Frank E. Swift brickyards. The building is trimmed with white stone and its entrance was originally ornamented with figures of Justice and Liberty. A decorative clock tower stands at the southwest corner of the structure. Arches on the south and west sides, near the entryway, boldly proclaim the year of construction, 1886.
