Statement of Significance:

Criterion C - Architecture:

308 South Street (c1890) is a good local example of a vernacular house form distinguished by a narrow, single pile, rectangular block with a gable roof flanked on either end by a stuccoed exterior chimney. A shed roofed front porch spans the entire facade. This particular house type, built between c1850 and 1900, is found primarily in south central Alabama.

Description:

308 South Street is a single story, three bay, frame structure with a gable roof flanked on either end by a stuccoed exterior chimney. The house shares the same lot with the McMullan-Skinner House (#4) and faces onto a dead-end street. A shed roofed porch spans the entire facade. The front wall of the house is covered with flush board siding. The back of the house has two 20th century additions.

The interior features a center hall floor plan with original floors, baseboards, doors, architraves, narrow pine board paneling and simple vernacular mantels.
