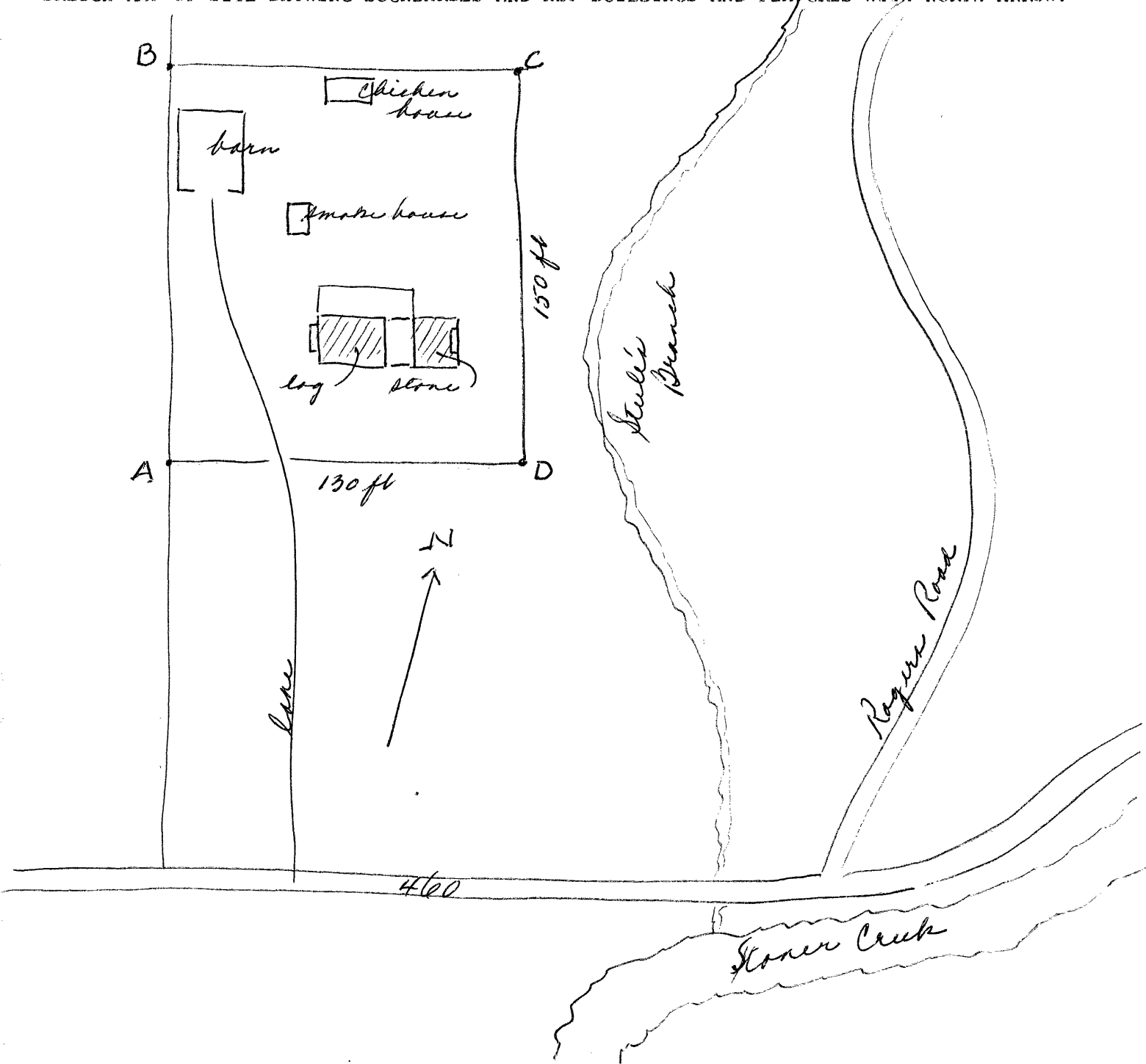

VERBAL BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION & JUSTIFICATION

Beginning at A at the fence corner in the SW corner of the yard, thence with fence around yard N 150 ft, E 130 ft, S 150 ft, and W 130 ft to the beginning. containing the log house, stone wing, smoke house and later barn and chicken house; about 1/2 acre.
