

Verbal Boundary Description

Acreage .3 ACRES

The site has no significant boundary markers. Thus, the site is bounded by a domestic living space delineated by imaginary lines running parallel to the structure on all sides at a 30' distance. Beginning at point A, an intersection of imaginary lines approximately 35' from the SW house corner; thence along a line SE approximately 110' to point B, said line running 36' SW of the SW elevation; thence NE along a line approximately 115' to point C, said line running 30' SE of the SE elevation; thence NW along a line approximately 110' to point D, said line running 30' NE of the NE elevation; thence SW along a line approximately 115' to the beginning, said line running 30' NW of the NW elevation.
