DODD HILL CHURCH
The first church in Dodd Hill was built in 1800 by the Rev. John C. Dodd. It was a log cabin and was used for many years. In 1850 it was replaced by the present building. The church was destroyed by fire in 1870 and was rebuilt in 1875. It is now a place of worship for the Methodist Episcopal Church, South.

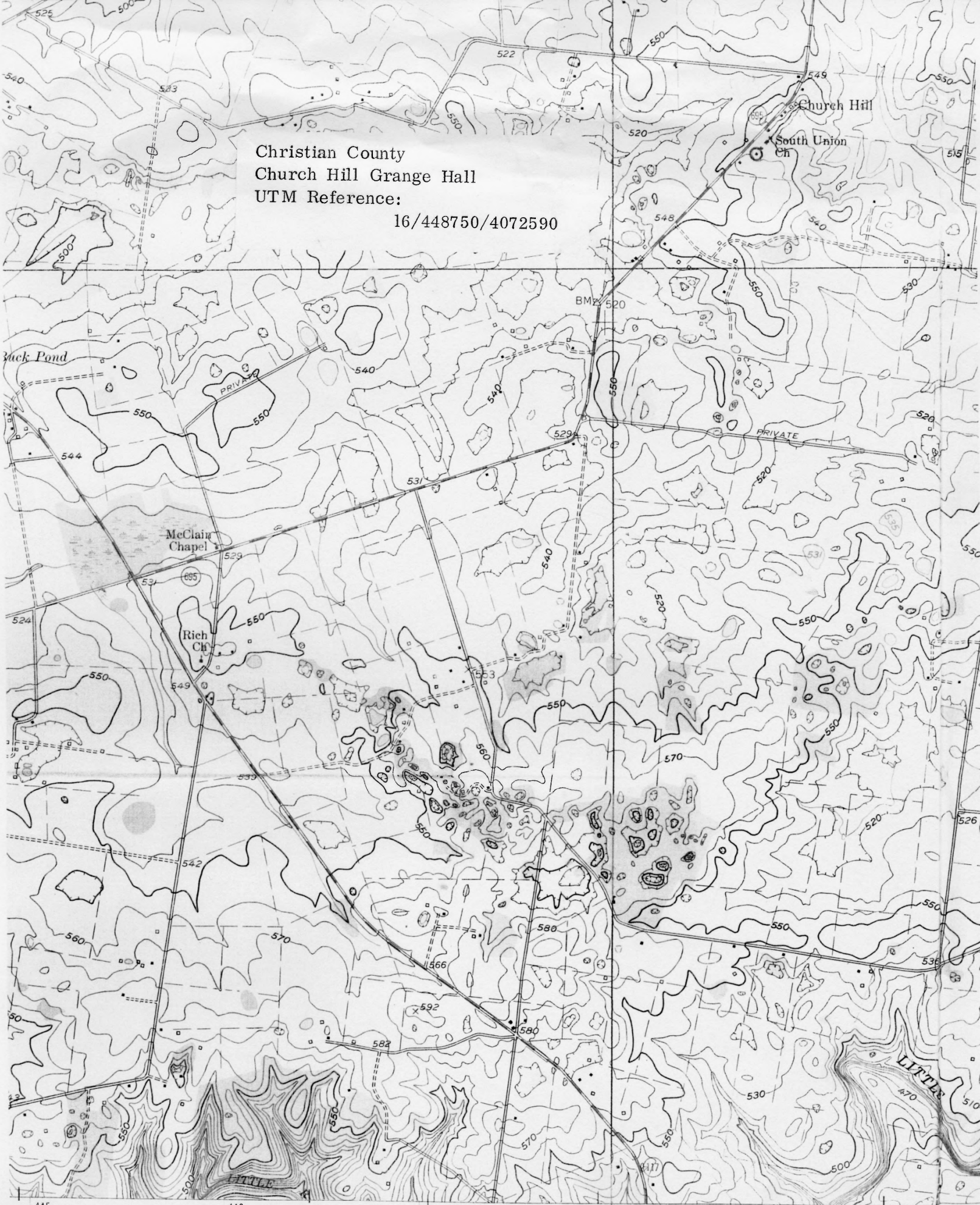
