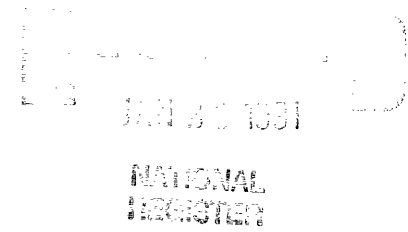

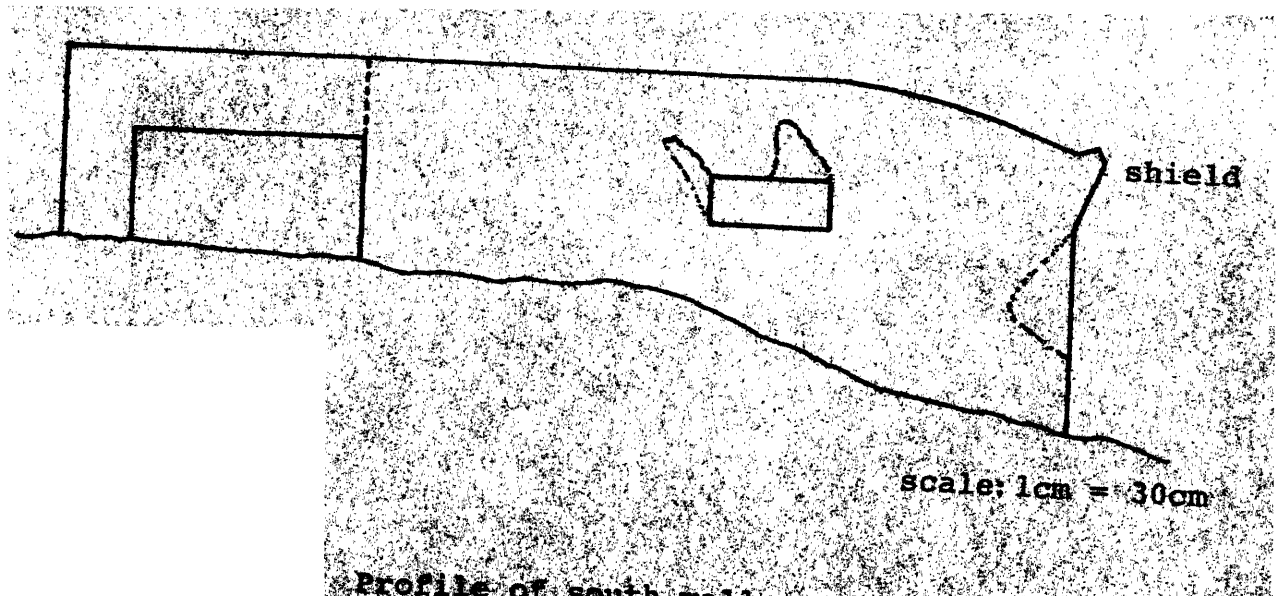

The Pago Pillbox I is situated on the shoreline of Pago Bay approximately 120.0m northeast of the mouth of the Pago River and 1.0m inland from the high tide line. Built of steel-reinforced concrete mixed with crushed coral and beach rubble, the structure is in good condition, although it is partially buried by sand which makes it difficult to determine the original height.

The structure measures about 4.0m by 2.70m. The east wall extends north of the west wall. The entrance is located on the north or landward side of the structure. The south wall is .50m thick; the west wall is .30m thick; and the north and east walls are .25m thick. Horizontal impressions of the boards used to build the form into which the concrete was poured are apparent on the interior and exterior walls.

The roof, which is about .35m thick, slopes towards the south wall and forms an overhang which extends about .13m over the embrasure which is situated in the south wall. The gun port has a view of Pago Bay. A window in the west wall has a view of the river. The interior space forms one room. The floor is sand. The interior height of the structure cannot be determined due to the accumulation of sand inside.
