20. Significance This exceptional hall-parlor plan house has excellent Federal detailing and is most certainly a survivor from the late eighteenth century. It was constructed by William Clinkenbeard on property which was patented out of Strode's Station. Soon after its initial construction, a one-story brick wing was added.
