4. Owner: Dr. Douglas Hughes, 508 University, Las Vegas, NM
7. Description: T-shaped plan; stuccoed foundation of unknown material; stuccoed wood frame walls; asphalt shingle roof; moderate overhang, enclosed, frieze boards; cut-out barge board; 2/2, 1/1 double-hung windows with board surrounds; two single doors one with transom; lumberyard classic columns. Like the next two structures (#'s 998, 1001), this house is located between the **Douglas-Sixth Street Commercial District**, and the **Library Park and North New Town Residential Districts**, in a formerly residential area, now residential, residential converted to office, office, small commercial and parking.
8. Significance: Built between 1883 and 1886 this is a very good example of the local Wood Vernacular type. The influence of the picturesque cottage movement is clear in the asymmetry and decorated barge board. The porch was added or, perhaps, remodeled about 1910, using stock classical columns.
