

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#### **Description**

Located on County Road 236 at its crossing of Coop Creek, the Coop Creek Bridge is of the open masonry substructure type. It consists of two spans, the longest of which measures 22 feet. The total length of the bridge is 44 feet, the curb-to-curb width is 18 feet, and the total width is 21 feet. The abutments and the central pier are all of stone masonry construction and the deck is reinforced concrete. A simple reinforced concrete balustrade runs along both edges of the deck.

#### **Significance**

Constructed in 1940, the Coop Creek Bridge is associated with the World War II Era historic context and is of the open masonry substructure type. Though the identity of its original designer does not survive, it was constructed in conjunction with the Arkansas State Highway Commission and thus may well have been designed by one of that state agency's engineers. Given its relatively intact condition it retains sufficient integrity to remain associated with its historic period; it is thus locally eligible under Criterion C.


