STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Jammie Seay House, believed to be the oldest house within the present limits of Spartanburg, is a good example of log cabin construction.

Built between 1770-1800, the house belonged to Jammie Seay, a Revolutionary War soldier of the Second Virginia Infantry who was born in Virginia in 1752 and died in Spartanburg County in 1850.

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Columbia architect, Walter Petty made the following statement concerning the architectural significance of this house: "Despite its terrible physical condition, this is an unusual example of the early log house with the log structure protected from the weather by wood sheeting. The interior showing the log construction work exhibits a degree of craftsmanshiphot usually found in cabins of this period. The fieldstone chimney, of the 'pipestem' form is not typical of South Carolina and probably evidences the fact that Jammie Seay was a native of Virginia, where this type chimney (laid in brick) was very typical. I think this should be restored as a fine example of a pioneer residence."
