Boundary: The block on which the courthouse sits surrounded by two streets, forming an oval.

Acreage: less than one

The cross plan of this courthouse is similar to the Twiggs County plan. It sits on a small square in the center of town. The facade has a pyramidally capped tower flanked by pavilions also with tall pyramidal caps. The rear pavilions are octagonal with similar caps. The side elevation features a hip roof with intersecting gables between the end pavilions. Round arched and rectangular windows are on the first floor; round arched windows are on the second floor. All have emphasized keystones. The brick is laid in an American bond. A stringcourse encircles the building between the first and second stories as does a water table at the base of the first story. Wooden doors remain at the entrance.

The interior has plaster walls with a wooden wainscoting. Some asbestos tile flooring has been added in the courtroom and adjacent offices. Three stairways lead to the second floor.
