to the point of replacement. The Colorado Department of Highways designed this Pratt deck truss and let the project out for bid. The construction contract was awarded to M.E. Carlson. Using steel components fabricated by the Minneapolis-Moline Power Implement Company, he completed the bridge in 1937. It features a heavily skewed riveted Pratt design, with opposing diagonals at the end panel points and steel stringer approach spans on both ends. With sub- and superstructures unaltered, the bridge has remained in continuous use and is today in excellent condition.

Among the five riveted Pratt deck trusses included in the survey, the Arkansas River Bridge is the only one with a skewed configuration and is the longest-span example. Mounted high over the Arkansas River on spill-through concrete piers, it is the most visually impressive of the group - an excellent example of later highway truss design and construction.
