Description The Confederate Monument in Glasgow is a bronze statute of a Confederate soldier atop a pedestal of limestone. The statute, approximately six feet tall, depicts a Confederate soldier at parade rest. He rests upon his rifle. He is wearing a bed roll, a canteen and a kepi hat. The bronze statute sits atop of a fairly inornate pedestal of limestone. The southern face of the pedestal is inscribed: "C.S.A. Our Confederate Dead 1861-1865." The other faces of the pedestal are unadorned. The monument was placed on the courthouse lawn.

Statement of Significance The Confederate Monument in Glasgow meets National Register Criterion A and is eligible under the context of "Civil War Monuments in Kentucky, 1861-1935." This monument is an excellent example of a monument erected to celebrate the Lost Cause and the Confederacy. There are no trappings of morning or loss with this monument, it is located in a prominent place in the City of Glasgow and likely was the center of a great celebration when it was unveiled.

Verbal Boundary Description - The Confederate Monument whose boundaries form a circle with a radius of ten feet centered on the monument located on the south side of the courthouse lawn in Glasgow.

Verbal Boundary Justification - The area associated with the monument is restricted to the ground on which the monument sits and a small buffer around it. The setting outside such a restricted area is not seen as critically important to maintaining an integrety of association. Because the focus of the multiple property submissions is the significance of the monuments, their proposed area of listing will reflect that they have been considered by-and-large, in isolation from their surrounds.
