DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Bethel Methodist Church is a Southern rural church similar in design and construction to many country churches which once dotted the southern landscape. With the advent of centralization, many of the structures have been left abandoned to decay. Bethel Methodist has been not only physically maintained, but is today still functioning as a religious institution. It is, therefore, a prime example of a past genre of Southern building.

The 1901 structure is a 20' x 40' rectangle with 6" pine siding. The entrance is marked only by a set of double doors. Sides are divided into four bays. The sanctuary end is marked by three irregular spaced openings. The roof is a tin gable. On the interior the ceiling and wall surfaces are finished in beaded pine siding. The ceiling is cove-like in configuration. Carpets cover pine plank flooring. Furnishings are simple with a storey and Clark reed organ and wooden pews.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Old Bethel Methodist Church and School Building, located at the old Finch Community, typifies the simple, rural vernacular public building that was built before or just after the turn of the century in Arkansas. The history of this building illustrates well the history of the small community of Finch, as well as the history of most small rural communities in Arkansas. It is significant both architecturally and historically as the sole visual reminder of a part of Greene County's history, which is rapidly being forgotten.

The original Bethel Methodist Church was constructed in 1880, a small, one-story, white frame church. In 1900, a storm destroyed this building and in 1901 an almost identical building replaced the original structure. George Russell, a local carpenter, built the building using native materials of cypress and pine. It measures 20 feet by 40 feet and has a high pitched roof covered by tin. Exterior walls are covered with six inch beveled pine siding, while interior walls and ceiling are beaded pine wall board. Adjacent to it is a cemetery that dates to 1886.

Primarily a Methodist Church, Old Bethel also served duty as a school for the Finch Community until 1926. Finch once was a thriving farming community, but soon after the first World War, Finch met the same fate as many other rural Arkansas communities. People left the small communities to settle in nearby towns. A consolidation of the Finch School District #57 into the Walcott School District ended the educational service of Old Bethel. However, it had been an illustrious career, culminating in the production of five doctors and several other locally prominent persons.

Near the same time, the Methodist Church ceased having services in the building also. The building was used irregularly until 1941 when it was permanently vacated.

The years of emptiness and neglect seriously deteriorated Old Bethel. In 1973, the building was in poor condition with missing windows, rotted flooring and part of the west elevation missing.

A concerned group, many of whom had worshipped or attended school in the building or had family in the adjacent cemetery, began restoration of the structure. Today, Old Bethel looks much as it did at its completion in 1901. It is used for church services when the weather is mild, and has become a source of great community pride.

Old Bethel Methodist Church is one of the few historic buildings which has survived in Greene County. As such, it is significant as a link with the rural heritage of Greene County which contributed heavily to Greene County's history. Architecturally, it is an excellent example of a simple, frame one-room church and school building of vernacular styling. Historically, Old Bethel illustrates the story of the decline of rural Arkansas farming communities just after the turn of the century. Located in a beautiful, natural setting of two acres with old pine trees framing it, Old Bethel Church and cemetery present a serene and graceful appearance to the world.

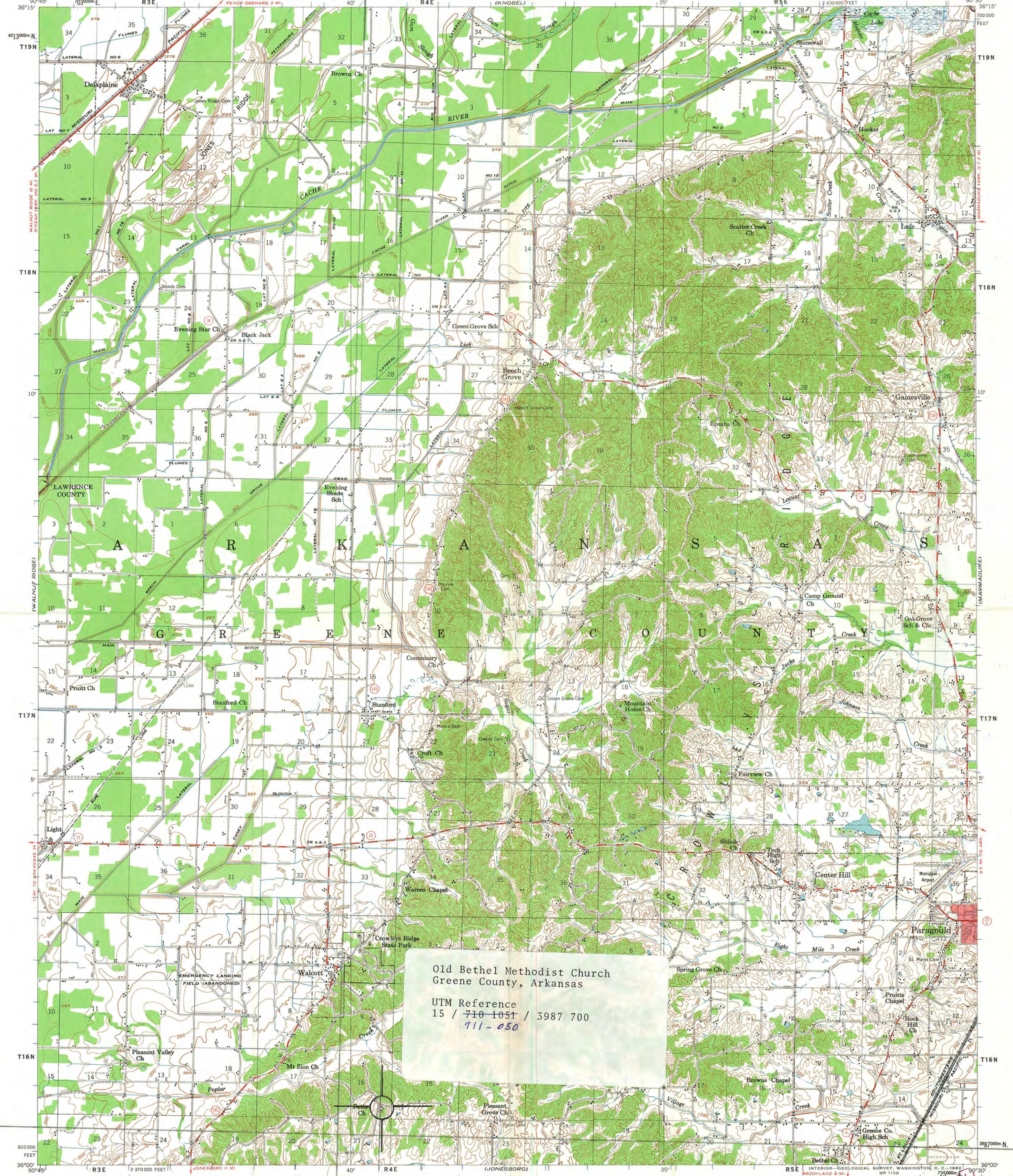

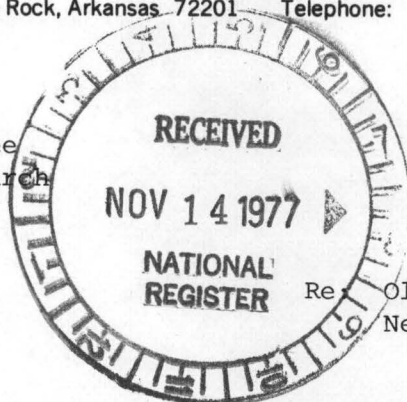

Dear Mr. Peacock:

Thank you for your letter of January 27, 1981, expressing your thoughts on the inclusion of religious properties in the National Register of Historic Places. We apologize for not responding sooner.

The criteria for evaluating potential entries for the National Register state that ordinarily properties owned by religious institutions or used for religious purposes are not considered eligible for the National Register. However, a religious property which derives primary significance from architectural or artistic distinction or historical importance does qualify for listing in the National Register. The impact on society of religion and religious institutions is recognized by the National Register criteria and provides a basis for the listing of many religious properties. There are a number of religious institutions in Arkansas which are listed in the National Register, including

Trinity Lutheran Church, Conway County.

Mount Olive United Methodist Church, Crawford County.

Selma Methodist Church, Drew County.

Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church, Franklin County.

Old Bethel Methodist Church, Green County.
