DESCRIPTION (Continued)

2 1/2 story masonry dwelling with pitched roof, and double-end chimneys (only one remains per side). Roof has standing seam metal covering and simple box cornice. The house is 5 bays long by 2 bays wide and has symmetrical fenestration with 6 x 6 sash. Each window has a flat-arch window head, and cut-stone sill. The entry is centered in an arched opening. Small paneled entry door has 4 round light overhead. Attached to the rear of the house is a 1 story ell with pitched roof.

19. HISTORICAL OR ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE  
Example of a rare, masonry house of the Georgian period. This house is like other Georgian houses along Palisado (209, 204, 248, and 273) except here it is executed in masonry. It can also be compared with the masonry houses at 130 Hayden Station Road and 108 Palisado Avenue except these have gambrel roofs. This house stands today along the historic palisado ridge, with much of its original integrity intact.  
The house was built by Taylor Chapman in 1764. In 1824, his grandson Edwin Chapman lives here. House sits opposite the old Bissell Ferry Road.
