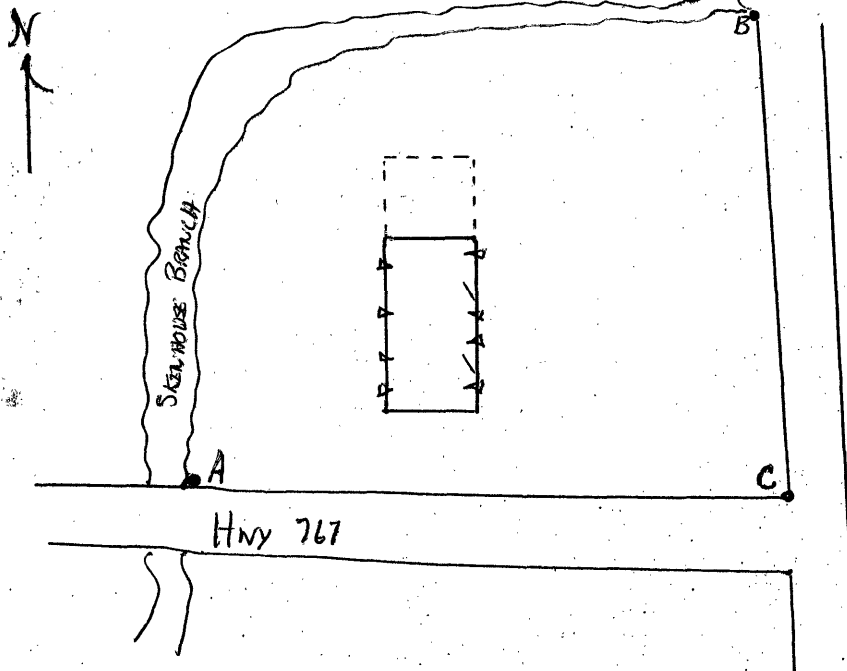

BEGINNING AT POINT (A) ON N SIDE HWY 767 WHERE SKENHOUSE BRANCH PASSES UNDER SAID HIGHWAY, RUNNING NORTHWARD ALONG SAID BRANCH AS IT COURSES TO A POINT (B) ON W SIDE OF HASKINSVILLE - MT. GILEAD RD. NEAR SAID ROAD APPROXIMATELY 100 YARDS FROM BEGINNING, THENCE S ALONG SAID ROAD TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH HWY 767 (C) THENCE W ALONG THE NORTHERN EDGE OF HWY 767 TO THE BEGINNING.
