

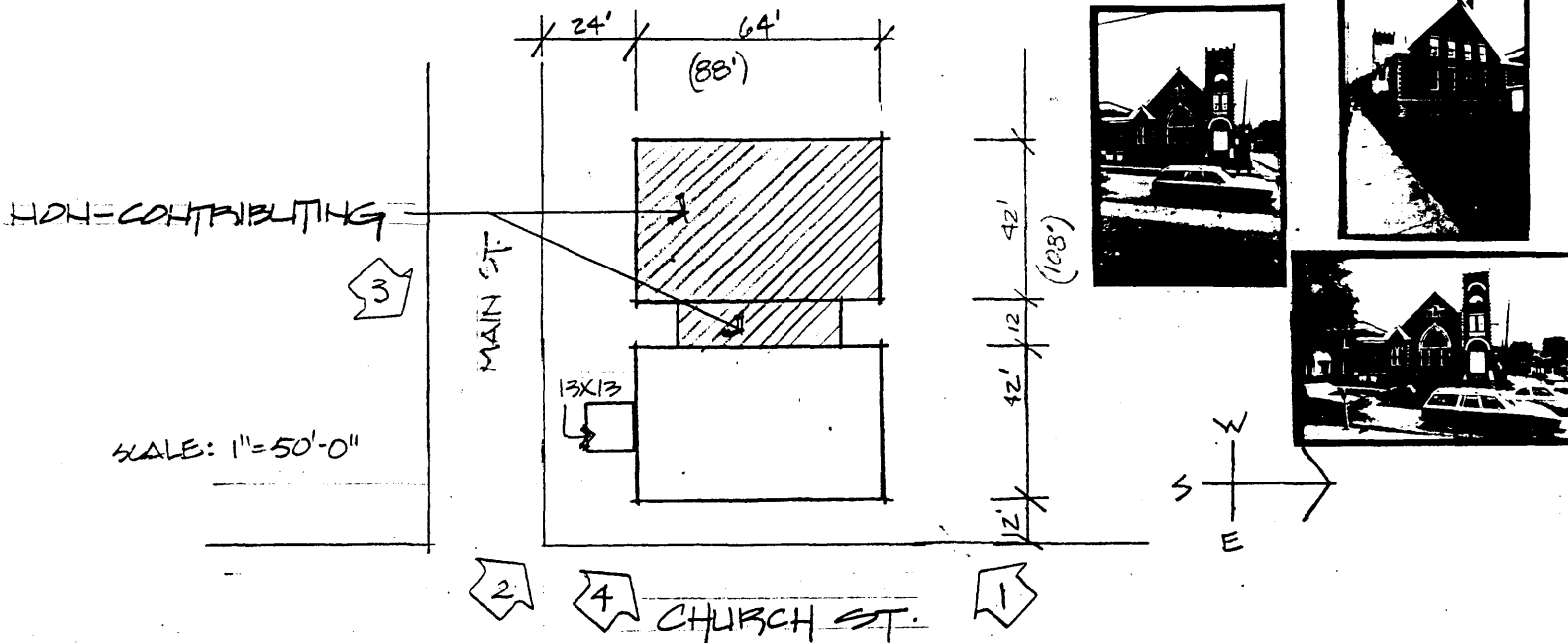

Verbal Boundary Description Acreage .22

Beginning at a point in the northwest corner of the intersection of Church and Main Streets; then west 108 feet along the north right of way of Main Street to a point; then north 88 feet to a point; then east 108 feet to a point; then south 88 feet along the west right of way of Church Street to the point of beginning.

The boundary includes all of the space associated with the First Methodist Church and one contributing building.
