

#### Physical Description

This large two-story house, faced with dark red brick, is capped by a shallow pyramid roof with an exaggerated overhang. Broad cross gables project on each elevation at the attic level. The full-length front porch unifies the facade from which one bay projects. The graceful, small-scale decorative elements of this porch are somewhat incongruous with the broad, simple massing which characterizes the house as a whole. Unusually fine detailed Tuscan columns with attic bases rest on brick plinths with cast stone coping and support the flat roof of the porch and the plain frieze beneath. These columns appear in groups of three at the porch corners. Simple pilasters frame the doorway which has beveled plate glass windows and sidelights.

#### Statement of Significance

The White House in the historic Mississippi River town of Helena, Arkansas was designed by Charles L. Thompson ca. 1910. This house is a good example of the transition from Victorian styling to the interest in Colonial Revival. Thompson usually designed transitional residences to be constructed of wood however, the White House is of brick construction. The house is a less ornamented version of this design than many of Thompson's frame transitional Thompson's design of the White House in Helena is reflective of the broad geographical distribution of his clientele. One of the oldest cities in Arkansas, Helena has always been more closely associated with nearby Memphis. It is considered significant that Thompson was commissioned to design structures in Helena in light of the distance and extensive travel time involved in going from Little Rock to the eastern Arkansas city. Although Thompson designed several buildings in Helena, the White House is the only one standing. of transitional design in brick and the wide geographic distribution of Charles L. Thompson's work in Arkansas, the White House is an important example of the work of Arkansas' most prolific historic architect.
