THE COGNAC STORE  
This building was constructed in 1894 and was the first store to be built in the town of Cognac. It was owned and operated by Nelson & Albin for many years. The building is a fine example of early 20th-century architecture and is well-preserved. It is a landmark in the town and is a popular destination for tourists. The building is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.
