
Ylig Fortification II (66-09-1174)

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The Ylig Fortification II is located on the sand about 100.0m south of the southern side of the entrance to Ylig Bay. The structure is situated 30.0m inland from the high tide line and has an elevation of approximately .50m above sea level. The fortification is constructed of large coral pieces joined together with cement mortar, a building technique introduced by the Spanish and used by the Germans.

The structure is in poor condition. The east wall and portions of the south and north walls are all that remain. The west wall is missing. It is not clear whether the walls were roofed. Segments of cemented coral rocks and rubble in the vicinity of the standing walls may represent missing portions of the feature.

The south wall has a thickness of .90m, the east wall .80m, and the north wall .70m. The top of the northeast corner of the structure measures 1.52m above the ground surface. The south wall has an embrasure with a view of the reef south of Ylig Bay. There is no gun port in the east wall.
