Foundation: Random brownstone & concrete block.

Exterior Wall Fabric: Wood clapboard & wood shingles.

Fenestration: 6/1 D.H. sash; D.H. sash w/ multiple panes in upper sash; 1/1 sash, single paned windows, & 2 windows w/ 9 lights each.

Roof/Chimneys: Intersecting gables w/ asphalt shingles. 2 brick chimneys.

Additional Architectural Description:

Raised front porch w/ turned railings & turned wood posts supporting a pent roof. Porch extends to a porte cochere.

Paneled & glazed entrance door appears to be original, as do stained glass portions of porch windows.

Decorative shingles & different window types characterize exterior, as do intersecting gables.

West roof shows a clipped gable w/ small, closely spaced brackets below.

A distinctive grouping of 3 windows projects below the south & west gable peaks.

Trellis work motif shows on the west porch gable.
