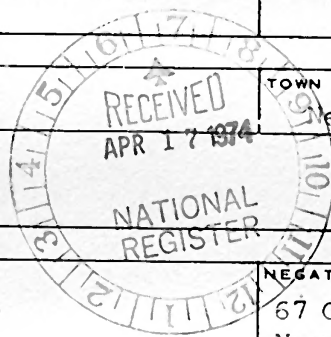

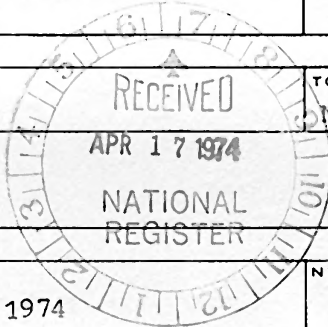
THIS MONUMENT  
Is erected to the Memory  
Of the Hon. RICHARD WARD Esq.  
Late Governor of this Colony.  
He was early in Life  
Employed in the Publick Service,  
And for many Years sustained  
some of the most important Offices  
In the Colony,  
With great Ability and Reputation.  
He was a Member  
Of the Sabbatarian Church in this Town,  
and adhered the Doctrins of his Savior,  
By sincere and steady Practice  
Of the various Duties of Life.  
He died on the 21 Day of August 1703  
In the 74<sup>th</sup> Year of his Age.  
And also MARY his Wife  
Who was a Member of the same Church,  
Fifty five Years,  
And in the 5<sup>th</sup> Season of her Marriage  
Truly & honestly in her Conscience  
She died the 30<sup>th</sup> of October 1703  
In the 28<sup>th</sup> Year of her Age.

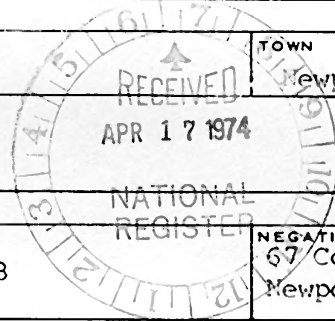

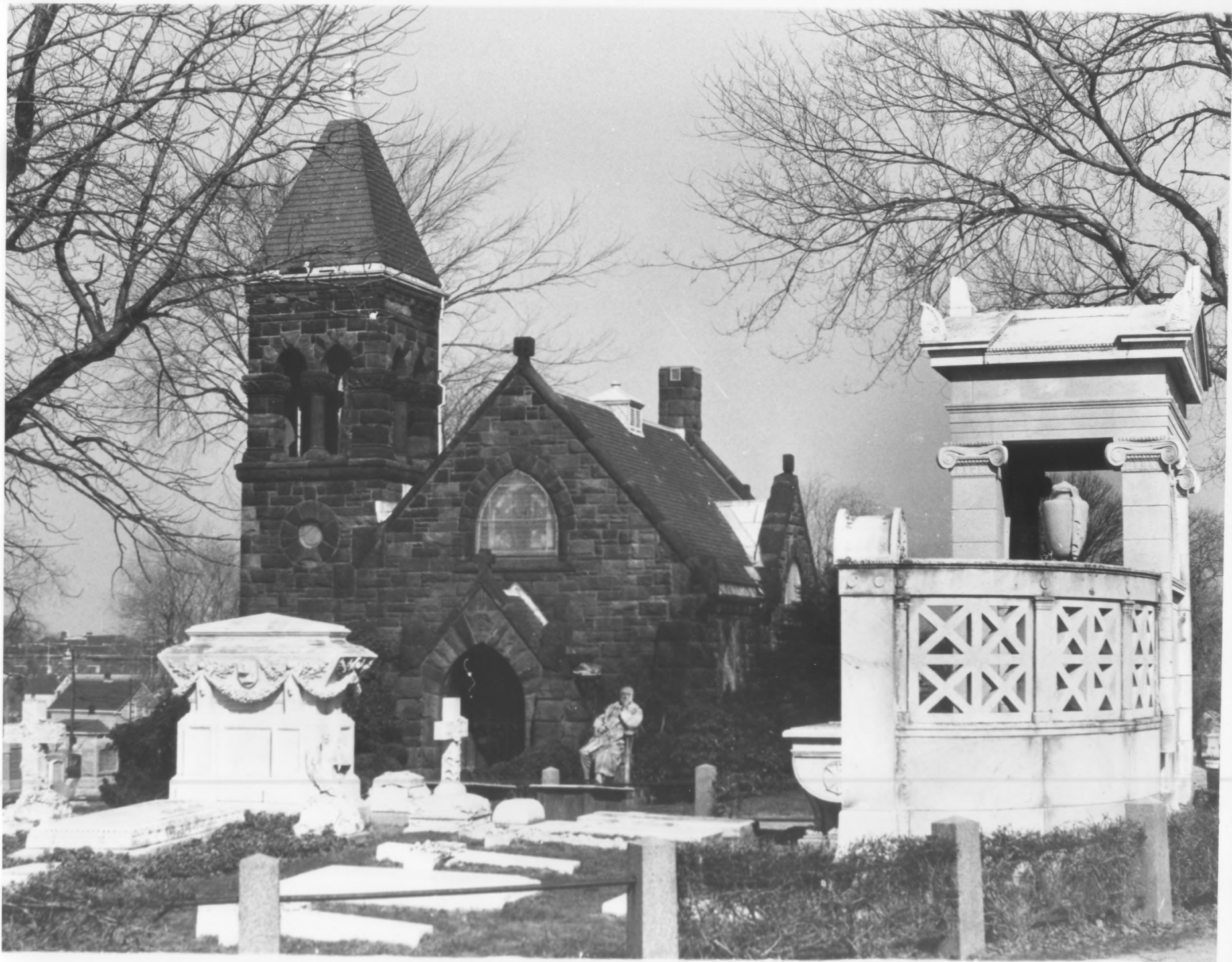

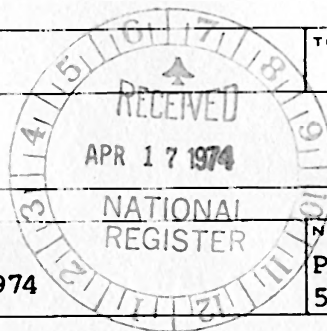
