The Casements at Ormond Beach is a two story structure executed in the shingle style. The house faces on fashionable Riverside Avenue with its main entrance just a few feet from the roadway. At the rear of the house were extensive terraced gardens which are now grown over and to the south is a circular drive. The building as it appeared at the time of its construction was described as "an unpretentious house of grey shingles with dark green and white scalloped awnings". The house was built by Dr. Harwood Huntington in the early 1890's and probably derived its name from the many casement windows in the living room walls. A photograph taken in 1930 shows that the awnings still existed and confirms the grey color (it was later to be painted white) and the casement windows with their diamond shaped muntins.

With the purchase of the house by John D. Rocke eller in 1918, many alterations were made. A large porch on the front was enclosed and the living room ceiling was opened up to create a skylight. The second floor windows are now four light sash placed in groups of three to correspond to the triple casements below. There is a fanlight with diamond shaped muntins over each group of casement windows. Cross gables extend from what is otherwise a nearly flat roof. Projecting from the south side of the house is a porte cochere which repeats the diamond pattern in its fanlights. From early photos, the porte cochere seems to occupy a spot which was used for covered parking. At the rear of the house are late additions of laundry and kitchen facilities, which are of stucco construction.

The Casements has been in a state of disuse for approximately eighteen months and although the condition of the building appears good on the exterior, it is structurally unsound.

Ormond Beach is a winter resort with many large estates along the Halifax and Ocean front. The development of the area began when John Anderson built the Ormond Hotel which was later purchased and enlarged by Henry M. Flagler. the notables who, came to Ormond to spend their winters was John D. Rockefeller "the richest man in the world". He was searching for a healthful place to spend the rest of his In 1914, he spent the winter season at the Ormond Hotel and did so each year following until his purchase of the Huntington Home in 1918. Dr. Harwood Huntington had designed and built the house in the early 1890's (we have been unable to pinpoint the exact date of construction). Rockefeller spent every winter in the Casements until his He died in the house on May 23, 1937.

After Rockefeller's death the house was purchased by Maud van Woy and the structure was converted to a preparatory school for girls. It later served as the Casements Junior College and in 1952, it was taken over by the Fellowship Foundation and converted into a retirement home. At this time all of the rooms were sold on an individual basis to persons in the home. Later these individuals got together to form Casements, Inc. which was bought out by the Lavin-Jensen Corp. At this point, the Casements was added to a chain of retirement hotels. The building is presently unoccupied and has been since early 1970.

In the selection of his home, Rockefeller chose a house which reflected the mood and feeling of Ormond. is built in a style which is structurally conducive to the temperate climate of the area, but which gives the visual effect of a rambling resort cottage. This is typical of the architectural styles which were popular in resort areas at the turn of the century.
