A shed roofed frame addition was built across entire rear; plaster and chair rail applied to stone walls in this addition. Plan altered-stair now ascends from rear addition only. [Needs further study: Does chair rail of partition wall match rear room or main house? Any clues of old partition wall? Changes in front door frames? Changes in stairway?]

A one room 16 foot frame wing was added to south end of house, and porch (now fallen) built on front. The stone house is sound, but the additions are not. House was repointed with concrete, scored.

Located in rolling meadow above descent to wooded valley of Clear Creek northwest of house. Cemetery on site northeast of house.
