Tooled masonry of unequal courses, of fossiliferous limestone; original mortar was loosely steepled. Voussoirs above openings; frames pegged, but not beaded; square wooden sills; cornice returned on front. One six panel door, one batten door, front**

16. made into door?) spacing, location of stud partition wall, and single chimney suggest an original side passage plan.

A shed roofed frame addition was built across entire rear; plaster and chair rail applied to stone walls in this addition. Plan altered-- stair now ascends from rear addition only. [Needs further study: Does chair rail of partition wall match rear room or main house? Any clues of old partition wall? Changes in front door frames? Changes in stairway?]

A one room 16 foot frame wing was added to south end of house, and porch (now fallen) built on front. The stone house is sound, but the additions are not. House was repointed with concrete, scored.

Located in rolling meadow above descent to wooded valley of Clear Creek northwest of house. Cemetery on site northeast of house.

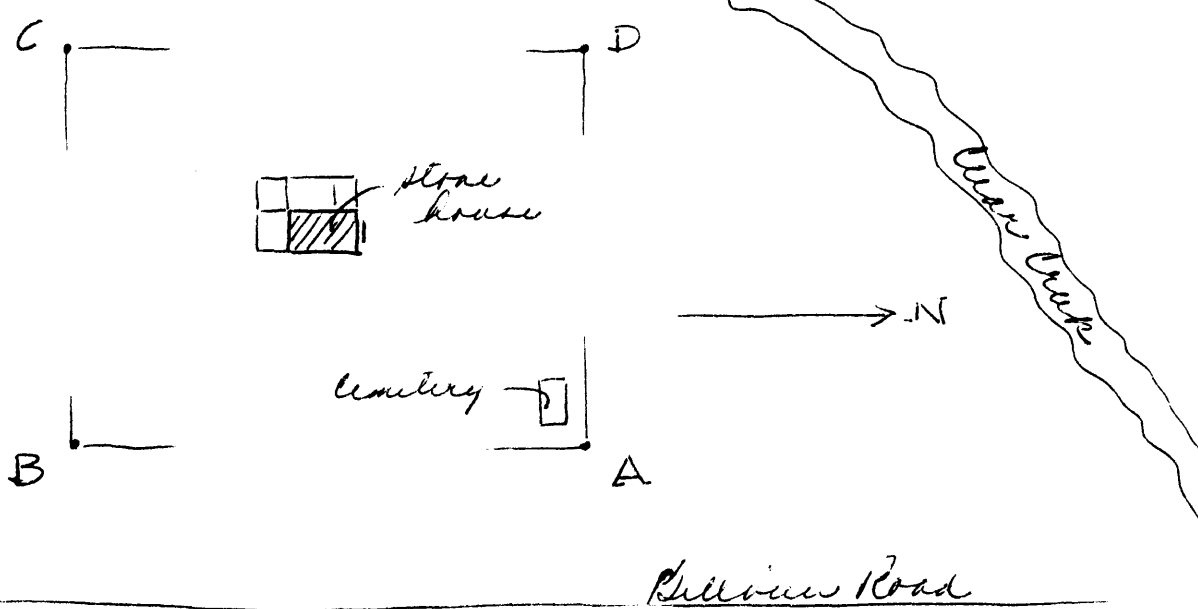
