Description of physical appearance & significant architectural features: (Include additions, alterations, ancillary structures, and landscaping if applicable)

This is a one story limestone example of the TYPE IV pair-house. The distinctive tripartite plan and indented porch are indicative of this particular variant of the house type. The two outside rooms are stone and laid up in coursed ashlar with raised mortar joints. The center section is adobe and has been plastered and marked off on the front to resemble stone. The house remains nearly as built, the only alteration being a shed roof frame extension which has been tacked onto the rear.

Statement of Historical Significance:

Construction Date:

The Jens Nielsen house in Ephraim is significant as an example of Scandinavian vernacular architecture in Utah. The house contributes historically to the thematic nomination, "The Scandinavian-American Pair-house in Utah."

Jens Christian Nielsen, a Danish farmer, claimed this Ephraim lot in 1869 and received the Mayor's Deed for it in 1872. Nielsen held this city lot into the 20th century and probably built this stone house around 1870. The historical records of the county contain no further information on Nielsen.
