Monument at Sycamore Shoals, near the present Elizabethton, Tennessee. Inscription: To the memory of the Patriots who on their way to Kings Mountain under Sevier, Shelby and Campbell, assembled here September 25, 1780. Erected September 26, 1909, by John Sevier, Bonny Kate, Sycamore Shoals, Chapters, Daughters of The American Revolution. "The Sword of Our Lord and of Gideon".

(Also) Here negotiated the treaty of Sycamore Shoals under which Transylvania was acquired from the Cherokees, March 19, 1775. (Also) Fort Watauga first Settlers fort built west of the Alleghenies.
