STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Significant as a center of county and city government for almost 150 years, the Old Court House now serves as the Conway City Hall. It is reputedly designed by Robert Mills who was still on the South Carolina Board of Public Works at that time.

Commissioners of Public Buildings for Horry District contracted with Major Russell Warren in March of 1824 to erect the district court house; completed by May 15, 1825, according to contract.

Commissioners of Public Buildings, finding that repairs on the old jail would be "injudicious ... for all the wooden parts are decayed", appointed Henry Durant July 9, 1825, to build a new jail which was to be finished by March 1, 1827.

In 1914 the Grace Hotel was built over the jail. Then in 1968, the hotel was torn down, leaving the original walls of the jail. Present plans are to restore the old jail for use as the Horry County Museum.
