

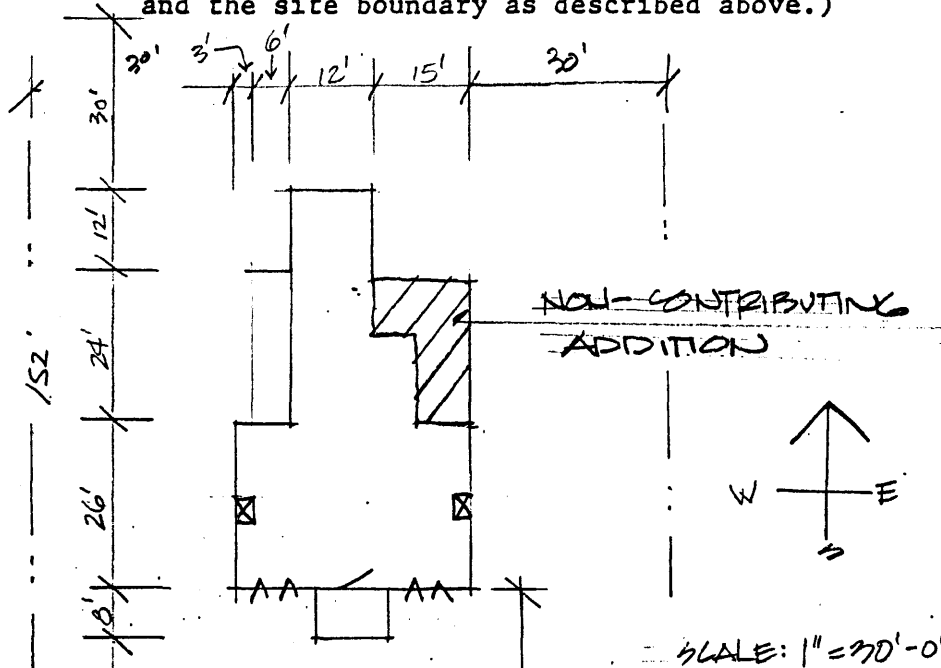

From a point in KY 1559, then north 152 feet to a point; then 96 feet west to a point; then 152 feet south to the right of way of KY 1559; then east with the right of way of KY 1559 96 feet to the point of beginning.

The boundary contains all of the domestic space associated with the dwelling and one contributing building.
