NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION

The # 15 Plank Voting House is situated on a large flat lot at 815 Plank Chapel Road in the City of Morehead. The voting house was named for its location and the land was deeded to the Rowan County Fiscal Court in May 1897 (Deed Book 6, p. 216). Citizens voted in the structure until 1987. Today it is the only remaining voting house being used as a rental residence. It is heated by the original pot bellied stove.

The # 15 Plank Voting House is constructed of fieldstone and flush mortar. Exposed beams project from the original standing seam tin roof. One over one windows are placed on the north and south elevations, with three 2' x 2' single lights located under the west gable eave. The windows have ashlar cut stone sills, but lack lintels. The three lights on the south elevation were positioned high to give light and to ensure privacy to citizens voting in three booths located under the windows. Victorian beaded boards seal the gable ends between the stone walls and roof. A capped yellow brick chimney is located at the center of the roof ridge.

NARRATIVE STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The # 15 Plank Voting House meets criterion A and is a significant physical representation of the New Deal. It was constructed by the WPA and used exclusively as a voting house during the period of significance. The # 15 Plank Voting House has retained a majority of the original materials and is recognizable in function as a voting house. The # 15 Plank Voting House is located in its original setting and location, and has retained its integrity of association as a building constructed by one of the New deal era agencies.
