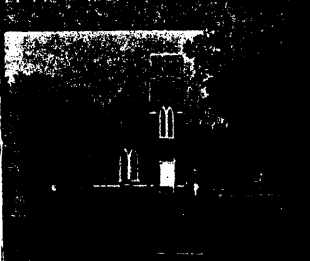

38. Stylistically pretentious churches in Warren County outside of Bowling Green are rare. This architecturally significant church in the small town of Smiths Grove is, with the exception of the idiosyncratic raking corbel table in the gable front, typical of end-of-the-century Gothic Revival. The corner entry tower serves as a local landmark, the building is essentially intact and there is a sympathetic rear addition.
