DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Monte Vista Main Post Office is a two-story rectangular box. It is an excellent example of a late Beaux-Arts post office with its monumental proportions and massive giant order Ionic colonnade fronting the loggia on the front elevation. The structure is topped with a tile hipped roof.

LOCAL CONTEXT

Monte Vista is an agricultural center which was formally platted and incorporated in 1886. It was originally called Lariat, and later, Henry. The post office is located one block south of the town's main street in an essentially commercial area. The downtown contains number of late-19th and early 20th century buildings, although none have been designated as historic and there is no historic district within the community.

A topographic survey made in January 1931 shows the site as vacant.

PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The building is constructed of red brick with a "combed" face, and has terracotta detailing. The lobby floor is terrazzo, while the workroom floor is maple covered with asbestos tile. There is a metal hipped roof with Spanish tile covering areas where the roof is exposed. The above ground portion of the basement is faced with limestone. The building has all of its original interior fixtures. Both the structure and the grounds are well maintained.

The building is rectangular and has a second story and full basement. The main entrance faces west.

The building is a late example of Beaux-Arts Classicism. The front facade is dominated by six flutes Ionic columns which reach to the top of the second story. Rectangular basement windows and doors have terracotta frames. The entabulature is terracotta with a boxed cornice and decorated frieze including dentils, egg and dart design, as well as a decorated pediment. Brick coursing rests on limestone which defines the top of the foundation.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The post office is a dominant structure in Monte Vista and is the community's finest example of Beaux-Arts-influenced architecture. It is of architectural significance on both state and local levels.

ARCHITECTURE

Though not completed until 1933, the Monte Vista Main Post Office relates directly to buildings constructed during the previous three decades, and not to the Starved Classicism style buildings typical of the Depression era government buildings. It is certainly one of the last purely Beaux-Arts buildings constructed for the Post Office Department. The structure is also interesting in that it lacks any of the Renaissance Revival details common to this general class of building.

The use of a central loggia flanked by slightly projecting wings is a hallmark of designs from the previous thirty years, and was one of the primary signifiers used in post office design. This concept monumentalizes the entrance. The building is thus significant under the National Register Criterion C on the state level as an excellent example of a type, period and method of construction. The Monte Vista Main Post Office retains substantial integrity of location, design, setting, materials, workmanship, feeling and associations. None Known.
