This octagonal frame house is set in a fine grove of poplar trees on a knoll about 1 1/2 miles northwest of Darlington on the Conowingo Road, U. S. 1.

Two stories high, the eight-sided roof is topped by an octagonal "captain's walk," flanked by two brick chimneys. faces southeast, as shown on the sketch on continuation sheet number one, with one or two openings in each wall. A narrow one-story wing runs northwest, 3 bays by 1. There is a threesided porch facing east, southeast, and south.

Entering from the southeast into a shallow hall, we find winding stairs on the left. Two doors in front of us lead into two parlors of equal size separable by sliding doors. has a fireplace back-to-back with one in each of two smaller rooms beyond, the old kitchen and the dining room, the kitchen fireplace is closed off by a new furnace flue. There are deep closets in each of these chimney walls, with one now made into a powder room.

The octagon fad, prevalent in the 1850's is found in barns, in one-room schools, and in four-story mansions; it was executed in many architectural styles from gingerbread Victorian to orientalesque mansions to the plainest little house; and it is found in all the contemporary building materials, even in an experimental poured concrete form in the 1850's. Windfell is a simplified Federal style, a moulding tops the boxed eaves, and is repeated on the porch above its octagonal pillars.

The six-panelled front door in a plain frame is topped by a four-light transom. Windows have six lights over six behind louvered shutters. Inside we find that doorways have no mouldings, doors have four panels, mantlespieces are of simple federal design downstairs while upstairs there are mantle shelves on brackets. The stairway has two turned banisters on each step under a walnut handrail.

Perhaps unique to this house are the exterior walls whose construction is of narrow planks laid horizontally, nailed from above as the work proceeded, forming an almost solid chinking in the walls if there is framing, or forming an almost solid wall if, as is thought, this is the method of construction.

Treatment at the corners has never been reported since this method is visible only under the shutters of the false window to the left of the front door, a window that would have opened out from the side of the staircase, but is placed to complete the symmetrical appearance of the house.
