DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

In the late 1880's a predominating architectural style was a Romenesque mode created and used most effectively by Henry Hobson Richardson. His influence can be seen throughout the country. The Rush County Courthouse, constructed in 1896, is a well preserved example of this style.

The 3 1/2 story structure is sheathed in rock faced stone although the structure is supported by a heavy steel frame, an early use of this material. The irregularly shaped building is highlighted by a square clock tower with a pyramidal roof with conical turrets. The four towers at each end of the building have pyramidal roofs. The main area has a steep red tile hipped roof. Stone pendants accent the edges of the main roof's verges. The cornice is boxed with a decorated frieze. All windows have the characteristic rounded arches excluding the rectangular first floor windows. A smooth stone course acts as lintel and sill for the second story. A projecting entablature above the course supports the engaged Corinthian columns. The third floor columns are less decorative as is the entablature above this story. The windows are set back giving a massiveness to the building. The entrance is a wide segmental arch at ground level.

The interior is enhanced by marble wainscoting and plasters. The floors are Venetian >Mosaie. The walls are stone and the floors and ceilings are what is known as hollow file, flat arch construction. The 3rd floor contains two large stained glass windows. One is believed to be the largest stained glass rendering of the Seal of Indiana to be found in the state. Much of the original quartered oak furniture and light fixtures are still intact.

From the 196 foot tower which can be seen for miles down to the small stone finials, the Rush County Courthouseis a exquisite well maintained example of one of the first strides towards modern architecture. It also remains a vital part of the governmental proceeding of Rush County.

#### STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Built in 1896, the Rush County Courthouse stands today as a unique example of 19th Century courthouse construction and architecture. The building itself is a monumental proportions. Its size dominates the entire community and can be seen from miles around. Constructed for approximately \$125,000, it would be impossible to duplicate today.

The hand carved stonework on the exterior, plus the hand carved woodwork inside represent skills that have nearly become a lost art. Also of significance are the two large stained glass windows that are located on the third floor. It is believed that one of the windows presents the largest rendering for the state seal in existence.

It is significant to note that over the years the building has undergone little alteration from its original appearance. Even at this writing, contracts are being signed to restore the exterior of the building and replace the tile roof. Interestingly enough, the County Commissioners located the same firm that supplied the original tiles in 1896.

This courthouse, by serving as the seat of County government, has touched the lives of every citizen of Rush County.

It has, by vertue of its monumental design, careful maintenance and central location become the central landmark in Rushville.
