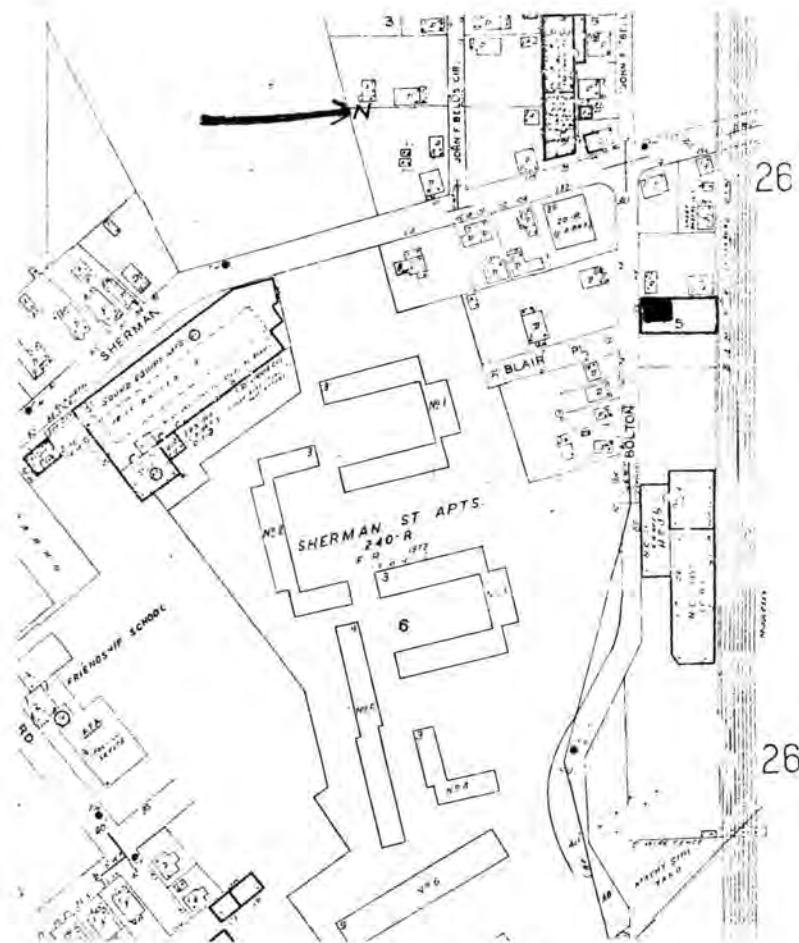

9. Historical significance (include explanation of themes checked above)

The structure at 73 Bolton Street was erected in 1852 for Patrick Slowey, a laborer. It is a typical North Cambridge workers cottage, a single-story frame house on a high basement, executed in a transitional Greek Revival-Bracketed Italianate style. It is considered the best example in Northwest Cambridge of an original workers cottage, the only one to have original siding and shutters. It is an important example of this housing type, which may be unique in North Cambridge and the only one in unchanged condition.
