

The significance of this house lies in its fine state of preservation (the elaborate Federal style moldings of the interior are intact), in its being a particularly clear example of a Federal style I-house (the only addition is a porch in the angle of the ell), and in its links with "A Kentucky Tragedy," the triangular love affair of the 1820s known also as the Beauchamp-Sharpe Affair, most recently treated by Robert Penn Warren in World Enough and Time.
